



A 100kW solar system is set to be switched on at Port Adelaide's Custom House next month.

Second large solar system close to completion in Port

PRECISION Group will soon switch on a second solar installation at Port Adelaide – at the Customs House commercial hub adjacent to Port Adelaide Plaza.

It follows the installation of a \$1.3m solar system at Port Adelaide Plaza, which was switched on in January.

Customs House adjoins Port Adelaide Plaza and is home to 200 government naval and maritime authorities' workers across 5240sq m.

Its 100kW solar system con-

sists of 240 panels spanning about 760sq m – the equivalent of four tennis courts. It will go live in October.

The system, which costs more than \$130,000, will reduce carbon emissions by 81 tonnes each year and will generate 22 per cent of the base building load of Customs House.

Port Adelaide Plaza and Customs House centre manager Samantha McInnes said the group had continued its partnership with Autonomous

Energy, which supplied and installed the system.

"Precision Group is committed to the implementation of innovative and sustainable practices to reduce the impact that our properties have on the environment," she said.

"We are proud to have achieved a five-star NABERS rating for Customs House. Our focus now is to monitor and manage our energy consumption and drive improvements to exceed the expectations of our stakeholders."
